

## **Geography Teachers of Primary, Junior and Middle Schools**

### **[Grades 1-9]**

#### **Outline**

The Geography Teacher reports to the Head of Section of the King's School, Shenzhen International.

All teachers have shared responsibility for smooth daily running of the Primary School as an entity - and for maintaining the general ethos, routine and pedagogy in line with the King's School – as directed by the Head of Primary School and the Founding Executive Principal.

In so doing, they should:

- ensure that the School's rules and policies are maintained
- attend School meetings and public events
- support co-curricular events and activities

#### **Safeguarding, Student Welfare and Pastoral Care**

All teachers:

- must ensure that they are fully aware of policies and practices with regard to safeguarding and student welfare
- must ensure that they adhere to the published systems
- must be role models to all students at all times

#### **Responsibilities**

1. Responsible for Geography teaching, after-school tutoring, homework correction and class management.
2. Provide Termly or Half-Termly and Weekly planning of lessons to meet the needs of the students.
3. Drill deep into teaching materials and teach students according to their aptitude.
4. Actively create conditions, carry out a variety of extra-curricular activities, cultivate students to improve interest in learning, broaden horizons, increase knowledge, and train related skills.
5. Monitor behavior, relationships and social development of the students in the class.
6. To research and summarize new developments in teaching.
7. Actively cooperate with school activities and other related affairs.

8. Assistance with the After-School Club (shared responsibility).
9. Maintain positive links and effectively promote the facility within the local and wider community.
10. Support the Admissions team by effectively communicating information to prospective families to the School and to provide guidance, support and reassurance.
11. Represent and positively promote the School at local events as required.
12. Perform any reasonable duties as directed by the Head of Section or the Founding Executive Principal.

### **Skills and Experience Requirements**

1. Bachelor degree or above in Geography.
2. Have corresponding subject Teacher Certificate.
3. Familiar with teaching materials, and speak standard mandarin.
4. Love education, abide by the law, have a good moral character.
5. Good at learning, actively accept new ideas of education, have certain research or thinking in the application of information technology and school information construction, have strong curriculum design and development ability, can master and use information technology for teaching.
6. Proficient in English listening, speaking, reading and writing, be able with bilingual teaching, have overseas study and work experience is preferred.
7. At least 5 years of teaching experience in relevant courses in international schools.
8. Preferred condition: those who have won the titles of "teaching expert", "academic leader", "backbone teacher", "excellent teacher", "famous teacher", "model class teacher" are preferred.

### **Personal Requirements**

1. Be a good professional at all times, in tune with the aims of the School, who always prioritises the students' welfare.
2. Be modern and flexible in approach to teaching and learning, prepared to adapt and learn new methods.
3. Be comfortable and active in the use information technology for teaching and learning.
4. Show initiative and independence but also be a good team-worker.
5. Be willing and open towards areas of self-improvement.
6. Have a good sense of humour.
